# WOMEN HOODED CABLED SWEATER

Skill Level- Intermediate

**Shown in Size – Small**

## Sizes

Directions are for women's size small, Medium.

## Finished Measurements

Width – 17(18)"

Length – 23.5(24)"

Sleeve Length – 19.5(19.5)"

## Materials

TERRACOTTA # 2979 (100 Gm) – 6(7) Hanks

Straight Knitting Needle Size # 9 (5.5mm).

Crochet Hook Size # F(4 mm)

Horn Buttons - 2 Buttons

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

## Gauge

16 sts = 4"; 24 rows = 4" in St st on # 9 Needles

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

## PATTERN A (16 sts)

Row 1 – p2, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2.

Row 2 and all wrong side row- knit all knits and purl all purl

Row 3 – As row 1.

Row 5 – p2, CR3, CL3, CR3, CL3, p2.

Row 7 – p3, C4B, p2, C4B, p3

Row 9 – p3, k4, p2, k4, p3.

Row 11 – As row 7.

Row 13 – p2, CL3, CR3, CL3, CR3, p2.

Row 15 – p2, k2, p2, C4B, p2, k2, p2.

Row 17 – p2, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2

Rep last 4 rows – 2 times more

Row 27 – As row 15.

Rep design from row 5 to 27 throughout.

## CABLE B – 8 STS

Row 1 – knit

Row 2 – Purl

Rep last 2 rows – 3 times more

Row 9 – C8B

Row 10 – Purl

Row 11 – knit  
Row 12 – Purl  
Re from row 1 to 12.

### **CABLE C – 6 STS**

Row 1 – knit  
Row 2 – Purl  
Rep last 2 rows – 2 times more  
Row 7 – C6B  
Row 8 – Purl  
Rep row 1 to 8.

### **BACK**

With Needle Size # 9 and Shade No # 2979

Cast on 80(84) sts and work as follows –

Row (RS) – k4(k6), p3, k5, Pattern A – 16 sts(Row 1), k5, p3, Cable B – 8 sts (Row 1), p3, k5, Pattern A – 16 sts, k5, p3, k4 (k6).

Row (WS) – p4, k3, p5, Pattern A (Row 2), p5, k3, Cable B (Row 2), k3, p5, Pattern A (Row 2), p5, k3, p4.

Work even in pattern set until pc measures 15", ending with WS row.

### **RAGLAN SHAPING**

Bind off 6(7)sts at the beg of next 2 rows. – 68(70) sts

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Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Row (WS) – p4, work in pattern to last 4 sts, p4. – 66 (68)sts

Work 2 rows even as set.

Rep last 4 rows. – 2 times more – 60(62)sts

Now dec every RS row as set. – 16(17)times – 28 sts

Leave these sts.

### **FRONT**

Work as per back up to \*\*\*. 68(70)sts

Place marker at center.

Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work 1 st before marker M1K1.

Join another ball of yarn k1M1 work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Row (WS) – p4, work to last 5 sts, p5; other side p5, work to last 4 sts, p4.

Shape raglan same as per back. – 15 sts

Put these sts on st holder.

### **SLEEVES**

With Needle Size # 9 cast on 58 sts.

Row (RS) – k4 \* p2, k4, p2, Cable C – 6 sts \*

Rep \* to \* twice more, p2, k4, p2, k4

Row (WS) – p4, \* k2, p4, k2, Cable C (Row 2)\*

Rep \* to \* twice more, k2, p4, k2, p4

Work in pattern set throughout.

At the same time 1 st at both ends on row 11.

As – k2, k2tog, work to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 on row 23.

As – k1, ssk, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 on row 33.

As – ssk, work to last 2 sts, k2tog. – 52 (52)sts  
Work even until sleeve length measures 10" ending with WS row.  
Row (RS) – k1 M1 work to last 1 st m1k1. – 54 sts  
Work even until total length measures 14" (12)"  
Rep inc row once more. – 56 sts  
Inc 1 st at both ends when sleeve measures 17". – 58 (62 sts)  
Work even until sleeve length measures 17".  
Rep inc row once more. – 58(62) sts  
Work even until sleeve length measures 19.5", ending with WS row.  
Bind off 6 (7) sts at beg of next 2 rows. – 46(48) sts

### **RAGLAN SHAPING**

Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.  
Row (WS) – p4, work to last 4 sts, p4. – 44(45) sts  
Dec at both ends. as set every 4<sup>th</sup> row – 6 times  
then every RS row 10(11) times – 12 sts

### **HOOD**

With Needle Size # 9 .  
Cast on 91 sts and work as –  
Row 1(RS) – k5, p3, Cable C(Row 1), p3, k5, p3, Cable C (Row 1), p3, k5, p3, k3, p1, k3, p3, k5, p3, cable C(Row 1), p3, k5, p3, Cable C(Row 1), p3, p5.  
Row 2 (WS) - p5, k3, Cable C(Row 2), k3, p5, k3, Cable C(Row 2), k3, p5, k3, p3, k1, p3, k3, p5, k3, Cable C (Row 2), k3, p5, k3, Cable C (Row 2), k3, p5.  
Work in pattern as set for further 6 rows.  
Row(RS) – Work to center, M1k, p1, M1k work to end. – 93 sts  
Rep last 2 rows. – twice more – 97 sts  
Row (RS) – Work to center M1p, p1, M1p. – 99 sts  
(now make Cable C on these 6 sts also)  
Work even for 5 rows.  
Rep last inc row once more. – 101 sts  
Work even for 3 rows.  
Row (RS) - Work to center M1k, p1, M1k, work to end. – 103 sts  
Work even for 3 rows.  
Rep last 4 rows once more. – 105 sts  
Work even for 7 rows.  
Row (RS) – Work to 1 st before center, p3tog, work to end. – 103 sts  
Work even for 3 rows.  
Rep dec row 3 times more  
Work 3 rows. – 97 sts  
Fold hood in half and join it with third needle.

### **FINISHING**

Sew side seam, sew raglan. Join hood by placing center of hood to centre of back with crochet hook. Make two loops and attach it to RS of front opening at 3" up from bottom and 6" up from bottom. Sew buttons corresponding to loops. Finish all loose ends.



## Shown in Size – Large

### Sizes

Directions are for women's size Large (X – Large).

### Finished Measurements

Width – 19 (20)"

Length – 24.5 (25)"

Sleeve Length – 20 (20)"

### Materials

TERRACOTTA # 2979 (100 Gm) – 6 (7) Hanks

Straight Knitting Needle Size # 9 (5.5mm).

Crochet Hook Size # F(4 mm)

Horn Buttons - 2 Buttons

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

### Gauge

16 sts = 4"; 24 rows = 4" in St st on # 9 Needles

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

### PATTERN A (16 sts)

Row 1 – p2, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2.

Row 2 and all wrong side row- knit all knits and purl all purl

Row 3 – As row 1.

Row 5 – p2, CR3, CL3, CR3, CL3, p2.

Row 7 – p3, C4B, p2, C4B, p3

Row 9 – p3, k4, p2, k4, p3.

Row 11 – As row 7.

Row 13 – p2, CL3, CR3, CL3, CR3, p2.

Row 15 – p2, k2, p2, C4B, p2, k2, p2.

Row 17 – p2, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p2

Rep last 4 rows – 2 times more

Row 27 – As row 15.

Rep design from row 5 to 27 throughout.

### PATTERN B – 10 STS

Row 1 – knit

Row 2 – Purl

Row 3, 5, 7 and 9 – As row 1.

Row 11 – C10F.

Row 13, 15 and 17 – knit.

Row 16 – Purl.

Rep from Row 1.

### PATTERN C – 8 STS

Row 1, 3, 5 and 7 – knit

Row (WS) – Purl to end.

Row 9 – C8F

Row 11 – knit.

## **BACK**

With Needle Size # 9 and Shade No # 2979

Cast on 86(92) sts and work as follows –

Row (RS) – k6(9), p2, k6, Pattern A – 16 sts, k6, p2, Pattern B – 10 sts, p2, k6, Pattern A – 16 sts, k6, p2, k6(9).

Work as established until length measures 15.5”.

## **RAGLAN SHAPING**

Bind off 8 (9)sts at the beg of next 2 rows. \*

Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Work 3 rows.

Rep last 4 rows. – 5 times more

Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Row (WS) – Work to end.

Rep this dec row every RS row. – 15 (17) times more

## **FRONT**

Same as back up to \*.

## **RAGLAN SHAPING**

Row (RS) – k3, k2tog, work to center, join another ball of yarn and work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Shape raglan same as back working both sides with different yarn until all dec complete. – 15 sts Leave these sts on st holder

## **SLEEVES**

With Needle Size # 9 cast on 64 (66) sts.

Row (RS) – k4(5), p2, k4, p2, Pattern C – 8 sts, p2, Pattern C – 8 sts, p2, k4, Pattern C – 8 sts, p2, k4(5).

Row (WS) – Work as appears.

Row 11 – k2, ssk, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Row 21 – k1, ssk, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 29 – ssk, work to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Work even as set until length measures 11”, ending with WS.

Row (RS) – Inc 1 st at both ends.

Rep inc row evenly 10 (8) rows – 3 (4) times more

Working all inc into St st.

Work even until length measures 20” from cast on edge, ending with WS.

Bind off 8 (9) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Row – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Work 3 rows.

Rep last 4 rows. – 5 times more

Row – k3, k2tog, work to last 5 sts, ssk, k3.

Work 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows. – 12 times more

## **HOOD**

With Needle Size # 9 .

Starting at right front, right sleeve, back, left sleeve and left front.

Join another ball of yarn and work as follows inc 9 sts evenly in first row (no inc in first and last 10 sts)

Row – k5, p3, k8, p3, k5, p3, k8, p3, k5, p3, k4, p1, k4, p3, k5, p3, k8, p3, k5, p3, k8, p3, k5.

Work even in hood for 8 rows.

Row (RS) – Work to center st, M1, P1, M1 work to end (inc 1 st both side of center st)

Inc 2 sts at center as set every 4<sup>th</sup> row. – 8 times working 1 st inc into St st, next 2 sts into rev St st and next 2 sts into St st.

When hood measures 10”.

Dec 2 sts at center – 4 times every 4<sup>th</sup> row

Then work even for 8 rows.

Work to half and join hood with third needle bind off method.

## **FINISHING**

Sew side seam, sew raglan. Sew sleeve by leaving opening of 3”. Join hood by placing center of hood to centre of back with crochet hook. Make two loops and attach it to RS of front opening at 3” up from bottom and 6” up from bottom. Sew buttons corresponding to loops. Finish all loose ends
