TANGO



Long Waistcoat with small shawl collar in beige

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Size: Small

For bigger sizes (M and L) follow the instructions in brackets

MATERIALS:

5 balls Tango yarn (100grams / 3.5 oz) in beige
5 balls Tango yarn (100grams / 3.5 oz) in off-white
Size 11 (8 mm) straight knitting needle
Stitch holder
Crochet hook size K (6mm)
3 buttons

GAUGE:

Woven purled Stitch over 4 in = 10 cm: 12.0 sts by 20.0 rows
Garter Stitch

STITCH GLOSSARY

Garter stitch (shawl collar)

Woven purled stitch

(knitted over multiple of 2 stitches)

Row 1 (ws): purl

Row 2: * sl1 wyif, p1*; repeat from * to * ending with p1

Row 3: purl

Row 4: * p1, sl1 wyif*, repeat from * to * ending with p1

Note:

The waistcoat is knitted with the two colors held together and worked back and forth. The small shawl collar is knitted after you finish the work.

BACK

1. Cast on 27 (29, 31) st. on size 11 needles and knit in Woven purled st. Work for 36 rows and hold the stitches in a stitch holder
2. Knit the other side the same way
3. Set all stitches on the same knitting needle
4. Following the pattern knit the last st. of one half **together** with the first st. from the other half. 53 (57, 61) st. left
3. Knit in pattern for 18 rows and decrease 1 st. at the beginning and the end of the next row.
4. Knit 14 rows in pattern and increase 1 st. at the beginning and the end of the row. Repeat this twice.
5. Next row: shape armhole
6. Cast off 3 (3, 4) sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of every alternate row 3 times.
4. Work 44 rows in pattern and cast off all sts.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 27 (29, 31) st. on size 11 needles and knit in Woven purled st.

Work as described for the back

After you finish the 44th row for the armhole, shape shoulder by casting off 10 st at the beginning of the row. Knit the remaining st. in pattern for another 23 rows. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front reversing the shaping for the armhole and shoulder.

FINISHING

1. Sew fronts to back along shoulder seams. Sew both sides of collar and attach to the back.
2. Sew side seams
3. Try on your waistcoat to determine where you want to setup your collar and buttons.
4. With right side of work facing up, pick up the stitches between the marks and knit in Garter st. for 20 rows, dec. 1 st at the beginning and the end of every alternate row.
5. Dec. 2 st at the beginning and the end of every alternate row, twice. Cast off.
6. With the crochet hook make 3 chains each 1.5" long.
7. Place chains on the right front side and sew them. Sew on the buttons
8. Darn/weave in all loose ends.
